The 2019/2020 budget was discussed, there are no raises at this time, and annual budget is \$280,000.00 in income and expenses. The budget appropriations act was approved via roll call. G Kruskie-yes, J Hendricks-yes, S Krupa-yes. The budget hearing was adjourned at 7:12p.m. The regular meeting was reopened at 7:12p.m.
- VIII Unfinished Business:
 Alanson Library contract will not be able to be a year to year contract. We need to sign the contract and send it in. S. Krupa made a motion to approve the Alanson Library Contract for the three year term at \$1,743.00/year.
- Marijuana Ordinance will be discussed next month and a resolution will be passed one way or the other on the topic.
- Paving of Hill Rd. was discussed as Mr. Kredell came in before the meeting to ask why it has not been done yet. G Kruskie will get a quote, possibly talk to the BlissFest Organization to help with the cost.
