- I            Meeting was called to order at 7:00p.m.
- II           Agenda was approved as presented. L. Fineout made a motion to approve the agenda as presented and J. Hendricks seconded it. Motion carried.
- III          Minutes for the February 6, 2019 were approved as is. G. Kruskie made a motion to approve the minutes for the February 6, 2019 meeting as is and J. Hendricks seconded it. Motion carried.
- IV          The treasurer’s report was presented with receipts of \$90,624.09 for February 2019. G. Kruskie made a motion to approve the Treasurer’s report as presented for February 2019, L. Fineout seconded it. Motion carried. J. Hendricks mentioned that the tax roll was turned into the County on Monday without cause.

              Cheryl True thanked S. Krupa for allowing her to look through the files to see if she could find any by-laws for the Planning Commission.
- VII         Unfinished Business:  
              Marijuana Proposal that passed in November requires the township to decide whether or not they are going to allow recreational growers, distributors, or retail establishments in Readmond Township. The board discussed this and decided it should be tabled at this time. S. Krupa made a motion to table this until R. Kruzel returns, J. Hendricks seconded it. Motion carried.
- VIII        Correspondence:  
              A memo regarding Lakeview Rd. repair was handed out for the board to look at for further discussion at a later date.
- IX          New Business:  
              Building Rental/Use: should this be something we should look at again. After long discussion with regards to clean up, insurance, people in and out etc. the board decided to keep it as is and not allow anyone to rent/use the hall.

A resolution (2-19) pertaining to the Board of Review was presented and read by S. Krupa. J. Hendricks made a motion to adopt the resolution allowing a qualified property owner to file a written request with the July or December Board of Review to claim a Principle Residence Exemption, G. Kruskie supported it. The vote was done via roll call. The resolution was accepted with a 4-0 vote.

Middle Village Budget was presented to the board and is asking that each entity to budget for \$2,000 this year. J. Hendricks made a motion to approve the budget of \$2,000 for the Middle Village Park, G. Kruskie supported it. Motion Carried.
